The Nigeria Higher Education Foundation Essay Competition (NHEF), New York, USA, hereby invites interested students to participate in the 2nd Nigeria Higher Education Essay Competition.

Essay Topics

- **1.** "The educated differ from the uneducated as much as the living are form the dead"- Aristotle. Discuss the validity of this statement.
- **2.** Can an improved higher education sector significantly affect Nigeria's long term economic growth?
- **3.** What is the role/function of innovation versus tradition in Nigeria's development?
- **4.** The key to unlocking Nigeria's potentials lies in its youth". Discuss.

Eligibility Requirements

All students enrolled in their penultimate year (*third year undergraduates of a 4- year degree programme or fourth year undergraduates of a 5-year degree programme*) at any Nigeria Higher Education Foundation partner Universities are qualified to participate in the essay competition. NHEF partner Universities include Ahmadu Bello University, Bayero University, **University of Ibadan**, University of Nigeria, Nsukka and the University of Port Harcourt.

Submission Essay Criteria and Procedure

- No literary form other than an essay will be accepted;
- ➤ Each piece of writing must reflect the contestant's ability to explore and discuss ideas and ethical concepts;
- Essay must demonstrate the conduct of research and a sufficiently detailed summary;
- ➤ Essays must be 2000 words in length, double spaced, standard font, and numbered pages with one inch margin excluding bibliography and title page;
- Each essay must be submitted in Microsoft word or PDF format;

- > References in the essay should be included and clearly identified and;
- ➤ All entries must be submitted via email to info@thenhef.org by 11:59p.m.(WAT) on March 31st ,2016

Prizes

The grand prize winner of the 2016 Essay Competition will be awarded a cash prize of N100, 000.00k with a year of paid tuition. The First runner up will be awarded a prize of N75, 000.00k with a year of paid tuition. The second runner up will be awarded N50, 000.00k with a year of paid tuition.
