Senate: Decision Extracts from the Special Meeting of Senate Held on Tuesday, 3 May, 2016

A Special Meeting of Senate was convened to discuss the prevailing students' unrest that led to the closure of the University. The meeting held on Tuesday, 3 May, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. in the Senate Chamber. The following decisions were taken:

- 1. Ratification of the steps taken by Management which led to the closure of the University;
- 2. That Mr. Tunji Michael Ekpeti could not be reinstated immediately until Council meets to consider his appeal;
- 3. Senate approved the establishment of a bipartisan committee to find out the immediate and remote cause of inadequate supply of power and water on the campus;
- 4. The issue of unauthorized fine in the halls of residence should be dealt with administratively; and
- 5. That Academic Studies should not resume until all the pending issues have been resolved.
