GUIDELINES ON 2020 CONGREGATION ELECTIONS

This is to inform members of Congregation that the following procedures shall guide the Congregation Elections scheduled for **Wednesday**, **29 July**, **2020** during which **Congregation Representatives** on the following bodies shall be elected:

- **SEARCH TEAM (2 to be elected**-one of who shall be a Professor)
- UNIVERSITY SENATE(153 to be elected)
- UNIVERSITY BOARDS & COMMITTEES (other than Council)-as earlier advertised

OPTION A (VOTING AT YOUR LOCATIONS)

- E-Voting Platform shall be deployed from 8.00 am on Wednesday, 29 July, 2020.
- ❖ Voting shall commence from **8.00am** and end at **3.00pm**.
- All accredited voters can vote on the E-Voting Platform using the code to be forwarded before the Election Day.

OPTION B

- ❖ IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO VOTE DUE TO SOME TECHNICAL REASONS, kindly visit the Voting Centre in the Trenchard Hall to cast your vote with a valid University identity card.
- ❖ Internet ready computer systems will be available to assist you cast your vote
- Once you are accredited to vote, an officer would be on hand to assist in the process.
- Having voted, you are expected to exit the Voting Centre immediately

GENERAL

- Voting shall not be by proxy.
- ❖ An accredited voter is only allowed to vote once.
- There shall be no campaign inside in the Voting Area.
- After voting is over, the candidates with the highest number of votes cast shall be declared the winners for respective positions.
- Any proven attempt to vote more than once/ subvert the election process shall be deemed as **gross misconduct** and treated accordingly.
- ❖ If it is discovered after the elections that any candidate who was not qualified to have contested, for whatever reasons won, such a result would be annulled and awarded to the candidate with the next highest vote for that position.
- ❖ At the close of voting at 3:00pm, Congregation meeting will hold via this Zoom link: Register in advance for this link:

After registering, you will receive a confirmation e-mail containing information about joining the meeting.
