SUSPENSION OF LYING-IN-STATE CEREMONIES

This is to inform the University community that in view of the recent observed rise in number of cases of COVID-19, the Federal Government of Nigeria announced that the nation has entered a second wave of the pandemic as well as imposition of rules in order to forestall further infection or spread.

Consequent upon the above, and the advisory received from the Director, University Health Services, Management has decided that lying-in-state and similar activities that encourage display of corpses/dead bodies should be disallowed until further notice.

This is in compliance with the government directives on the COVID-19 protocols.
