APPRECIATION OF THE ACTING VICE-CHANCELLOR, PROFESSOR ADEBOLA BABATUNDE EKANOLA, MNAL, fspsp, TO THE UNIVERSITY COMMUNITY ON THE FIRST MEETING OF THE NEW GOVERNING COUNCIL

Dearly esteemed colleagues,

Permit me to thank you for your kind cooperation and candid display of commitment during the recent maiden visit of our Pro-Chancellor and Chairman of Council, Chief John Odigie- Oyegun. Permit me also to share with you his impressions about us and our campus.

The Pro-Chancellor and Chairman of Council strongly expressed his admiration of the level of peace and cordiality among staff in spite of the difficult experience we went through last year about the selection of a Vice-Chancellor. In his view, a people's willingness and ability to quickly put aside their differences and focus on the progress of the collective is a heritage worth commending, and an example worth showcasing to the rest of the nation.

While reiterating his determination to upscale both staff welfare and the teaching-learning facilities on our campus, the Pro-Chancellor and Chairman of Council urges us to treat the improvement of the global ranking of the University of Ibadan as both a personal and a collective challenge.
