CALL FOR 2021-2022 NOMINATIONS FOR THE UNESCO-HAMDAN BIN RASHID AL-MAKTOUM PRIZE FOR OUTSTANDING PRACTICE AND PERFORMANCE IN ENHANCING THE EFFECTIVENESS OF TEACHERS

The UNESCO in Paris is inviting nominations for the 2021-2022 UNESCO-Hamdan Bin Rashid Almaktoum Prize for outstanding practice and performance in enhancing effectiveness of teachers.
