TY Danjuma Fellowship in Nephrology

Call for applications for the ordinary Fellowship

The Akinkugbe Kidney Centre, University College Hospital announces the call for applications for the first phase of the TY Danjuma Fellowships in Nephrology, University of Ibadan in collaboration with the Akinkugbe Kidney Centre, University College Hospital, Ibadan, which will commence in June 2023. The Fellowship will be centred on nephrology and related fields, with the principal aims of promoting research and enhancing the knowledge and practice of nephrology in the sub-region, and will be based at the Akinkugbe Kidney Centre, University College Hospital, Ibadan.

Ordinary Fellows would be clinicians or academicians at their early career stages.

The duration of the ordinary Fellowship will be six months.

Contents

Fellows will participate in:

- a) normal activities in the relevant unit or department.
- b) a research project, preferably with a bias for tropical nephrology, which may be concluded within or outside the six months period. In the latter case, the major part of the project should be carried out in the centre.
- c) a chosen specific clinical activity of interest.

There is no stipulation of attendance at formal lectures, but participation at seminars would normally form part of unit or departmental activities.

Eligibility

For this phase, applications are limited to Registrars/Senior Registrars (with a pass in the membership/Part 1 Fellowship examination of the Medical Colleges), early career medical consultants (under 3 years) and lecturers (below senior lecturer) in the University College Hospital, Ibadan or the University of Ibadan. The Fellowship could run concurrently with the normal duties.

Each application should include the following:

- a) research proposal of up to 3000 words.
- b) clinical project/activity of interest.
- c) recommendation from the base institution or department.
- d) curriculum vitae including an electronic address and phone number.

A certificate of completion would be issued upon the successful completion of the Fellowship, and continued collaboration with the centre will be encouraged.

Support

An amount will be provided to all Fellows for research and incidentals. Additional amounts will be provided for transportation costs to Ibadan and back, accommodation and feeding for Fellows from outside Ibadan (not included in this phase). The exact amounts would be determined from time to time and would vary depending on the prevailing economic and social conditions. For this Fellowship award, the total amount for a Fellow may be up to Five (5) million naira.

Applications, which should include electronic and 10 hard copies, should be addressed to The Head, Department of Medicine, University College Hospital, Ibadan.

The closing date by which all applications should be received is 30 April, 2023 and successful candidates will be notified within 2 weeks.
