NOTICE OF STRICT STEPS ON STRAY ANIMALS' MENACE IN THE UNIVERSITY

The University public is hereby notified of the decision of the Management to take determined steps on the stray animals' menace on campus since the situation is, as it were, becoming an eye-sore.

It has become a common sight to see dogs, sheep, goats, and other domestic animals straying into conspicuous places like the Central Administration Building, Faculties and Halls of Residence.

Consequently, the community should please note that:

1. Such animals will henceforth be caught and sent to the Zoological Gardens to be fed to carnivorous animals there.
2. Identified owners of stray animals shall henceforth be processed to face the Staff Disciplinary Committee.

Members of the University Community, particularly residents who rear domestic animals are enjoined to note that careless handling of such animals is a grievous offence against extant regulations in the University and the Management will no longer take such with levity.
