REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE:

For Position No. 1: Candidate must possess five O'Level Credit pass (WAEC/NECO/GCE) in English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Physics and Chemistry plus a Degree in Medicine or its equivalent from a recognized institution registrable with the Medical and Dental Council of Nigeria (MDCN) and NYSC discharge/exemption/exclusion certificate with a valid/current practicing licence for the year in question.

For Position No. 2: Candidate must possess five O'Level Credit pass (WAEC/NECO/GCE) including English Language and Mathematics plus a degree in Pharmacy with evidence of registration with the Pharmacist Council of Nigeria plus at least six (6) years post qualification cognate experience.

For Position No. 3: Candidate must possess five O' Level Credit (WASSCE/NECO/GCE) including English Language and Mathematics plus B.A/B.Sc./B.Ed. degree in Mathematics, Statistics, Economics, and Educational Management with bias in Mathematics/Statistics/Economics with at least six (6) years cognate experience.

For Position No. 4: Candidate must possess five O 'Level Credit including English Language plus a degree in the relevant field (with a minimum of Second Class Lower Division) and NYSC discharge/exemption/exclusion certificate.

For Position No. 5: Candidate must possess five O 'Level Credit including English Language plus LL.B/B.L plus three (3) years cognate experience.

For Position No. 6: Candidate must possess five O 'Level Credit including English Language plus B.Sc. in Physiotherapy registrable with the Physiotherapy Board of Nigeria plus three (3) years cognate experience.

For Position No. 7: Candidate must possess five O 'Level Credit including English Language plus Doctor of Optometry (OD) degree or equivalent qualification registrable with the Optometrist and Dispensing Opticians Board of Nigeria and NYSC discharge/exemption/exclusion certificate with three (3) years post-registration cognate experience.

Demonstrable experience in PHP-backend and/or JavaScript-frontend development are mandatory. Strong knowledge of API communication protocols, mobile app development, database administration, computer hardware and analytical skills will be an advantage.

For Position No. 11: Candidate must possess five O' Level Credit (WASSCE/NECO/GCE) including English and Mathematics, 50/100 wpm and a recognized certificate of computer training plus six (6) years experience.

<u>For Position No. 12</u>: Candidate must possess at least five O' Level Credit which must include two science subjects in WASSCE/GCE/NECO including English Language with six (6) years cognate experience.

For Position No. 13: Candidate must possess at least five O' Level Credit including English and Mathematics in WAEC/GCE/NECO, 35/80 wpm and a recognised certificate of computer training plus four (4) years experience.

For Position No. 14: Candidate must possess at least five O' Level Credit including English Language in WASSCE/GCE/NECO with three (3) years experience.
