VACANCY: ARET ADAMS PROFESSORIAL CHAIR IN GEOLOGICAL STUDIES

The Board of Trustees of the Aret Adams Foundation has approved an Endowment Fund of One Hundred Million (\$100,000,000.00) in perpetuity. The proceeds of the endowment shall be for the funding of the Aret Adams Professorial Chair in geological studies at the University of Ibadan.

The endowment sum is ¥10 million annually and the Aret Adams Professorial Chair shall:

- (1) carry out extensive and scholarly research works on Geosciences studies;
- (2) organise two to three seminars annually on their research findings and other topical issues in Geosciences.

Application is hereby sought from renowned professors of Geology to fill the endowed Chair. The successful candidate is expected to be a thought leader with international repute in Geological studies. The candidate must show evidence of consistent publication, grant attraction and mentorship of postgraduate Students and Junior academics. The successful candidate will provide leadership, and work with colleagues to carry out cutting-edge research geared towards meeting industrial and societal need. The successful candidate is also expected to submit an annual report (including financial) to the Vice-Chancellor through the organs of the University *for consideration of the Endowed Professorship Chair Management Committee*.

Applicants are expected to submit the following documents to the Office of the Registrar on or before **Friday**, **28th January**, **2020**:

- 1. Application Letter.
- 2. Detailed Curriculum Vitae including Citation and H-Index.

3. Research Plan showing evidence of internal, international and industry collaboration, and mentorship.
